Terms and Conditions



1. All dogs using the pool for treatment and/or fun swims, do so entirely at their owner's risk.
2. To minimise risk, dogs must always be kept on a lead, unless safely in the pool area once all doors are closed. Please be aware that not all dogs are friendly, and some may be reactive to other dogs, especially if they are injured and receiving treatment.
3. Session fees will be charged at 50% if an appointment is missed or cancelled without a minimum of 24 hours notice.
4. All dogs should be seen by a vet prior to starting hydrotherapy to ensure the dog is suitable to swim. Vet referrals are advised by the Hydrotherapist for any dog undergoing treatment. It is the owner's responsibility to receive veterinary confirmation/bring a vet referral.
5. Dogs will not be admitted with contagious or infectious conditions, therefore will not be allowed to use the facilities with any eye, ear, skin or gastric conditions. Bitches in season may not use the facilities until their season is over.
6. Dogs must be as clean as possible when arriving for a session.
7. Owners are requested not to feed their dog for at least three hours before attending a session, and to try their very best to ensure dogs have been toileted. A cleaning charge may be requested if your dog soils the pool, as there is a high possibility we will need to close the pool to clean it.
8. We reserve the right to use video recordings or photographs during sessions.
9. Customers are reminded that they enter the pool area at their own risk. Due to hydrotherapy involving water, sensible footwear and clothing should be worn as there is an increased slip hazard around the pool area.
10. We reserve the right to refuse treatment to any dog at any time, or to muzzle any dogs that show aggression in order to continue the session safely.
11. Owners accept responsibility for loss or damage to personal property or vehicles whilst on our premises.
12. Shower and Drying facilities are provided free of charge.
13. Owners swim their dog entirely at their own risk during non-assisted sessions. We advise the use of the buoyancy aids provided, and please ensure dogs uses the ramp at all times.
14. The Hydrotherapist's decision is final.
